APPEAL POLICY  
RESOLUTION # 2021- 003

WHEREAS, the General Property Tax Act, Public Act 206 of 1893, MCL 211.30(8) allows the township board by resolution to allow a resident taxpayer to file a protest before the board of review by letter without a personal appearance by the taxpayer or agent;

WHEREAS, the Butler Township Board wants to make board of review appeals for all taxpayers convenient regardless of their residence status within or outside of the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Butler Township Board shall allow a protest to the board of review in writing by taxpayers of Butler Township whom are both residents and non-residents of the Township without a personal appearance by the taxpayer or agent;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Butler Township Assessor shall include a statement notifying taxpayers of this policy both in the notice of assessment and in any publications that are made advertising the March board of review.
